  - Jerusalem- political side

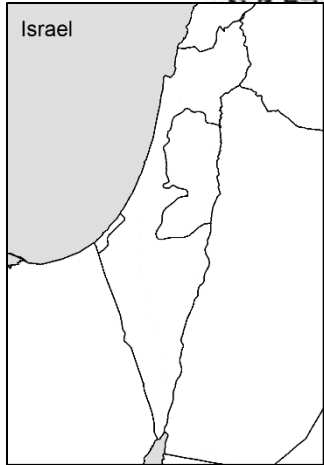

  - **Tehran**

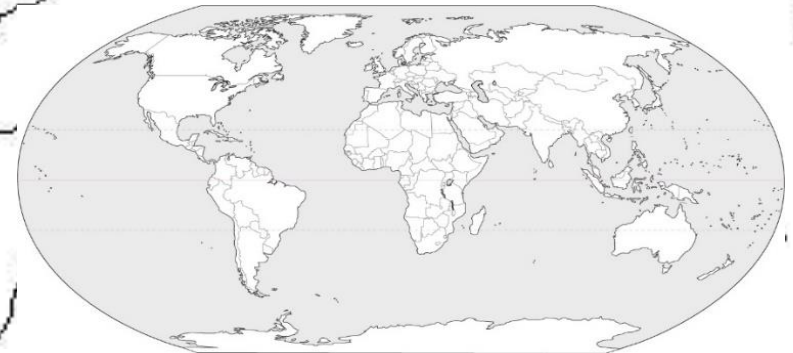
