2. **Place** a (●) at the location of a **city** and a (*) at the location of a **capital city**.

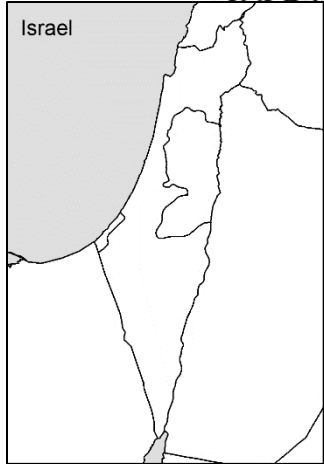

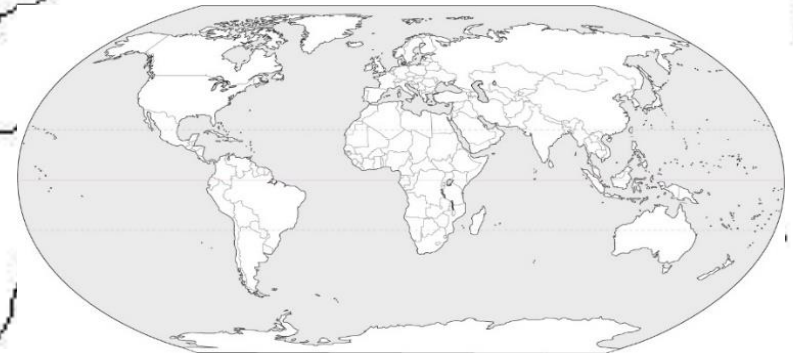
On the physical map:
